**SCHEDULE IPS-I-2**

**INDUSTRIAL POWER SERVICE - INTERRUPTIBLE**

**Availability**

Available in all of the territory served by the Corporation, subject to the Corporation's Rules and Standards for Electric Service.

**Applicability**

Applicable to consumers supplied at a single location who meet the following requirements for service:

1. Service to the consumer must qualify under the requirements set forth in the Industrial Power Tariff of Hoosier Energy Rural Electric Cooperative, Inc. (Hoosier Energy) and include a contract for interruptible service.
2. The consumer's minimum monthly interruptible demand must be at least 1,000 kW.
3. The consumer's monthly billing load factor must be at least 45 percent.

**Type of Service**

Service shall be three phase, 60 hertz, at available standard voltages.

**Determination of Maximum Demand**

The Maximum Demand shall be the highest consecutive 30 minute demand during the Peak Hours of the month expressed in kilowatts, but in no event less than 75 percent of the highest billing demand used in any of the preceding 11 months, or 500 kilowatts, whichever is greatest. Peak Hours are defined as those hours from 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m., E.S.T., daily. The Maximum Demand will be adjusted for power factor as provided below.

**Power Factor Adjustment**

The consumer agrees to maintain an average unity power factor as nearly as practicable. The Corporation reserves the right to measure such power factor at any time. When the average power factor in the billing period is less than 93 percent, the Maximum Demand shall be adjusted by multiplying the maximum 30 minute demand by 93 percent and dividing the product by the average power factor in percent.

### **Interruptible Demand**

Interruptible Demand is defined as the demand which is contracted for curtailment or interruption with the proper notification, expressed, in kilowatts, with the minimum being 1,000 kW.

### **Contract Demand**

Contract Demand is defined as the amount of demand, expressed in kilowatts, that the consumer contracts for minimum demand usage during the time of curtailment or interruption.

### **Billing Demand**

Billing Demand is defined as the Maximum Demand adjusted for power factor less the Interruptible Demand. In any event, the minimum Billing Demand shall be the Contract Demand.

### **Notification of Curtailment**

Hoosier Energy shall provide a 30 minute advance notice to the consumer before intentional curtailing or interruption of service is necessary for the contracted interruptible load and will provide consumer with an estimate of the duration of said curtailment or interruption. In any event, Hoosier Energy will provide consumer with notice of any probable interruption or curtailment and estimated duration thereof, as soon as practicable after Hoosier Energy becomes aware of the probability of such interruption or curtailment.

### **Customer Specific Contracts for Buy-Through During Interruption**

To provide an appropriate response to consumer's requests for buy-through of power during periods of interruption to meet unique competitive forces or other unique circumstances, upon receipt of consumer's written application and such further written information as the Corporation may require, the Corporation and the applying consumer, may, at the sole discretion of either party, commence and consummate negotiations of rates, terms, and conditions of service for a buy-through of power for the Corporation for the consumer pursuant to the Corporation's contractual arrangements with its all-requirements power supplier, if one or more of the following conditions is shown to exist:

- a. A single location of a consumer's business operations served by the Corporation is bisected by a boundary line between the Corporation's assigned electric distribution service territory and the assigned service territory of another electricity supplier; or
- b. Litigation is pending between the Corporation and the consumer concerning the Corporation's rights to be the exclusive power supplier to the consumer's location and/or

business operations which the Corporation and the consumer believe can be resolved only by such agreement.

If the parties reach a mutually acceptable agreement, it shall be reduced to writing and submitted to the Corporation's Board of Directors for approval. Upon request of the Corporation, the consumer, or the Corporation's all-requirements power supplier, upon good cause shown by affidavit, all terms and conditions of any contract under this tariff and any information contained in the submission set forth above shall be protected from disclosure as containing confidential, proprietary trade secrets pursuant to I.C. 8-1-2-29 and I.C. 5-14-3.

### **Notice of Change of Service**

If the consumer has been taking service under the buy-through provision set forth above and seeks, instead, to take service under a firm service offering available under Corporation's tariffs, the consumer shall, unless waived by the Corporation, provide the Corporation with one year's notice before it may take service under a firm service offering.

### **Curtailment or Interruptions**

The number of intentional curtailments or interruptions shall not exceed 12 per calendar year, nor one per day. Curtailment or interruption will be confined to the period from 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m., E.S.T.

### **Penalty for Failure to Comply**

If the measured consecutive 30 minute demand, expressed in kW, is greater than the Contract Demand by 10 percent during any curtailment or interruption period for the consumer, then the consumer shall not be eligible for this tariff for the next 12 month period starting with the month of failure to comply.

### **Billing kWh**

The Billing kWh shall be greater of the actual kWh used during the billing month or 328.5 times the monthly Maximum Demand.

### **Minimum Monthly Charge**

The minimum monthly charge shall be the greatest of:

1. A charge of \$1.00 per kVA of required transformer capacity.
2. The contract minimum.
3. The applicable facilities charge, if any, plus the customer charge and the demand charge.

### **Loss Compensation**

The demand and energy charges are based upon service metered at the Corporation's primary distribution voltage and do not reflect any compensation for transformation losses.

Demand and energy lost compensation adjustments shall be applied when metering is at a secondary distribution voltage:

Demand Compensation Adj.	\$ .10 per kW of Billing Demand
Energy Compensation Adj.	\$ .0003 per kWh

### **Other Wholesale Charges and Adjustments**

In addition to the base wholesale demand and energy charges which are included in the demand and energy charges of the Monthly Rate, the consumer shall pay all other charges billed the Corporation by Hoosier Energy for service hereunder pursuant to Hoosier Energy's Industrial Power Tariff.

### **Wholesale Rate Changes**

Should there be any changes in the Hoosier Energy Industrial Power Tariff under which the Corporation purchases power for service hereunder, the charges and provisions of Schedule IPS-I shall change correspondingly such that the change in wholesale power cost is passed through to the consumer.

### **Terms and Conditions of Service**

1. The applicant will be required to give satisfactory assurance by means of a written agreement as to the character, amount, and duration of the business offered.
2. In general, individual motors rated in excess of twenty (20) horsepower must be three phase.
3. Any transformers and regulation equipment which may be required for incidental lighting shall be furnished by the consumer.
4. In those cases where the consumer is not located where three phase service is available, and the Corporation elects to extend its facilities to make such service available, the Rules and Standards for Electric Service shall apply.

### **Fuel Cost Adjustment**

See Appendix "A"
